

INSPIRING LEARNING

Our schools are preparing students for the future by providing them with opportunities to explore and grow as learners in a safe, caring, and positive environment. Your role as a parent is vitally important in supporting your child as they enter Kindergarten. You can prepare your child by helping them build skills such as:

- Dressing and undressing themselves with minimal help
- Following three-step directions
- Telling stories and recounting events in sequential order
- Explaining what is happening in a picture when asked
- Taking turns and sharing with other children in small groups
- Sitting and listening to stories for 5-10 minutes
- Identifying their name and some letters of the alphabet
- Counting objects up to 10
- The ability to name some colours, shapes, and numbers



If your child will be five years old by December 31st of the current school year, they can start kindergarten in September.

To help families choose the right Kindergarten for their child, many schools host open houses in Jan/ Feb and then sneak peeks in spring. Parents and caregivers can also contact the school of their choice for more information or to register.

OUR KINDERGARTEN PROGRAMS

Kindergarten classes encourage individualized education through play and exploration, and our programs follow the provincial curriculum, which includes:

- Mathematics
- Science
- as well as Arts Education, Social Studies, Physical Education, and Health

Saskatoon Public Schools offers a variety of kindergarten programming, including:

- Nêhiyâwiwin Cree Language and Culture
- Montessori Casa
- Nature-based learning

Individual schools offer different program schedules which may include:

- Half-day, everyday
- Full-day, alternating days
- Full-day, every day

For students attending half-day kindergarten programs, a number of schools host KinderCare or daycare programs that provide care for students during the remainder of the day. Check with your school for more information.
