PREPARATION FOR CAMP

We will be welcoming 8 Heritage Michif speakers and facilitators, 5 Northern Michif speakers and facilitators and many Michif community members and old ones back to Batoche to learn and preserve our beautiful language of Michif. Your attendance for the full 6 days and participation in this camp will ensure that we continue to promote and revitalize our Michif language in both Greater Saskatoon Catholic Schools, Saskatoon Public Schools and beyond. CUMFI and the Michif community appreciates your dedication and time during the summer holidays to learn and preserve Michif language.

Our time together is a unique and fun-filled experience, when you arrive to camp, please check in at the Administration Building, to let us know you have arrived. We will be on-site Saturday, July 27th starting at 1PM and camp begins on Sunday, July 28th, 2024. We will give out registration packages and name tags. There will be a photographer and videographer on-site to capture some of our learning throughout the week. Please ensure you sign the consent form to have your picture taken and to potentially be interviewed.

Meals will be served out of the Dumont Lodge and breakfast is served from 8:00 AM – 9:00 AM Sunday to Friday. We will be having an opening ceremony starting promptly at 10:00 AM on Sunday, July 28th, 2024.

Please be at camp no later than 8:30 AM daily. The administration building will be open from 8:15 AM to 4:00 PM daily and we will have staff and volunteers on-site to accommodate participants' questions or any concerns. We have First Aid Responders on site and a First Aid Kit if you need. For an emergency, please call 911 immediately.

CAMPING COURTESY

Participants are strongly encouraged to stay on-site. Accommodations will be available in the Dumont Lodge & Cabins and Camping Tent & Trailer access will also be available. These have all been communicated and assigned prior to camp. Please ensure you bring your own bedding if you have been assigned to the lodge, cabin, or pavilion.

We will have access to electrical sites on the Back to Batoche grounds. We encourage people to park/tent and plug in close to the new lodge and to check in upon arrival. We will have a maintenace and groundskeeper, as well as cleaner on site but we ask that campers and those sleeping in the lodge and cabin pavillions, to leave their sites better than they found them. Please reach out to administration if you need the cleaners or groundskeeper for support with your site or the bathrooms. Fires are permitted (dependent on fire bans) and wood will be available on site as well. The closest trailer septic dump is in Rosthern, SK. We will have golf carts available to help with transportation on the grounds. Please check in with administration if you need support with moving around camp.

Pet owners are responsible for the behavior of their pets. Owners must clean up after them and dispose of any waste properly. The Arbor (big tent), all buildings and playground area are off-limits for pets. Pets must be kept on a leash at all times. Service animals are welcome, in the company of their handlers. Please keep service animals on a leash or harness during your visit.

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP

We will be providing three traditional Michif meals per day. We ask that all campers bring their own food containers, cups, and utensils to promote environmental sustainability (reusables is best). If you have severe allergies or need specialized dietary restrictions, please bring food that you can eat as we are not able to accommodate dietary restrictions.

- Chairs for visiting and sitting by the fire
- Sleeping bags, sheets, pillows, clothes for evening, bug spray and sunscreen
- Any food or snacks you might need to accommodate your dietary restrictions

CAMP MENU

Breakfast is served from 8:00 AM to 9:00 AM daily, and lunch from 12:00 PM to 1:00 PM. Food will be served from the Gabriel Dumont Scouts Lodge at the Batoche Site. There will be water stations available, please bring your own water bottle and reusable plates, bowls, and cutlery. Coffee urns and tea urn available throughout the day. Juice will be available with meals. There will be limited take-away packages, we are encouraging people to eat on site.



CHILDCARE



We have hired 3 Michif educators Desiree, Stephanie, & Leana to support looking after and caring for our children. Michif language and transmission is done best when our children are at the centre of our circles and learning. Childcare and Youth focused Michif activities will be provided from 8:30AM to 4:00PM in the building located closes to the Mainstage. Sunscreen and bug spray will be on site as well as snacks and water. Childcare does not run over lunch. Please pick up your children promptly at 12:00 PM to eat with you.

A variety of children's activities for different age ranges, will be provided throughout the day and families are encouraged to utilize the childcare so they can be fully immersed in their language learning experience. If children do come with you to your language session, please be mindful of the other learners and instructors. Children are welcome at our camp, and we hope to pass on our language and culture to them in a meaningful and Michif way.


