Dear Parents/Guardians of Grade 1, Grade 6 and Grade 8 students,

We are reaching out to seek your support for the upcoming 2024/2025 school fall immunization program for grade 1 students (not provided in schools, but by appointment at a public health office) and grades 6 & 8 students.

To facilitate this program effectively, we kindly request that all parents/guardians of children who are new to Saskatchewan or Canada and have not yet received immunizations in Saskatchewan, complete the form on page 2. Please submit this form along with your child's immunization records to the following email address:
