

Evan Hardy offers a rich educational experience for students within the classroom and beyond!



1. Theatre

Drama is one of the four strands of Arts Education. In future grades, students are able to register for Drama 10, 20, and 30 courses or our Musical Theatre Class as well as participate in performance as an extracurricular offering. Band classes are also held in the Theatre.



2. Music Room

Music is one of the four strands of Arts Education. Students may choose to take Band 9 as their elective in grade 9. Previous band experience is preferred, but not required. In future years, students can participate in Band 10, 20, and 30 as well as Instrumental Jazz and Guitar.

3. English Language Arts and the Library

Students in grade 9 take an English course each semester. Students will then take English 10, 20 and 30 in their grades 10, 11, and 12 years. Other electives such as Creative Writing 20 and 30 as well as Media Studies 20 complement the English courses. All students can take advantage of our Library which is open from 8:00—4:00 pm daily. Students can independently work at the cubicles or collaboratively at the tables. There are computers available as well as chess sets and other games. Feel free to enjoy a book in a comfy chair. Students can take advantage of the cell phone charging station while working in the library.



4. Advanced Placement

The Advanced Placement Program is administered by the College Board in the United States and is comprised of college-level course and exams that grade 11 and 12 students can take in high school. The AP classes offered at Evan Hardy are AP Art, AP Biology, AP Calculus, AP Chemistry, AP Computer Science, AP English, AP Physics and AP Psychology. 5. Home Economics

PAA09 is an elective for grade 9 students. Through the survey course, students are exposed to Clothing and Textiles, Food Studies, Drafting, Design Studies (3D printing and Lazer engraving) and Carpentry and Construction. In future grades, students can take advantage of this lab space for Food Studies 10 and 30, Practical and Applied Arts 10, Clothing and Textiles 10, 30, and Interior Design 30 as standalone courses.



6. Science

Science 9 and 10 give students the foundations needed to take the three strands of grade 11 and 12 sciences. The senior strands of grade 11 science include Health Science, Physical Science, Computer Science, and Environmental Science. In grade 12 the options are Biology, Chemistry and Physics.

7. Carpentry and Construction Woodshop

PAA09 is an elective for grade 9 students. Through the survey course, students are exposed to Carpentry and Construction, Computer Assisted Drafting, Design Studies, Food Studies and Clothing and Textiles. Students will be provided with instructions on safety and appropriate equipment use while working to complete projects such as an LED lamp. In the future, students can take standalone courses in both Computer Assisted Drafting as well as Carpentry and Construction.

8. Art Room

Visual Art is one of the four strands in Arts Education 09. Students can pursue other visual art opportunities in grade 10, 11, and 12 as standalone courses. Each grade students learn new or different mediums of art. Drawing is available as an Advanced Placement Class.



9. Photography Studio

In Photography 10, 20 and 30 courses students will be introduced to black and white photography, digital photography, and the printmaking process. Each student will have access to equipment in the lab including cameras, computers, and printing. This is a creative class that incorporates many technical skills.

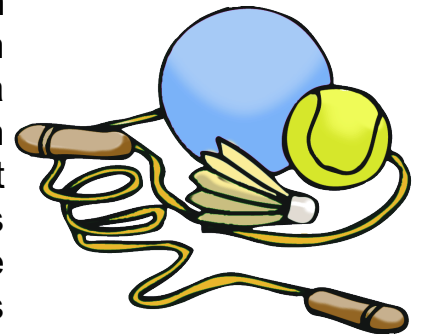
10. Media School Program



Grade 11 students from various collegiates in the city of Saskatoon and surrounding area come together for one high school semester to be immersed in an intensive film and television focused program. Students of this program get a thorough introduction to storytelling, script writing, acting in front of the camera, stages of production, roles on a film set, equipment, audio creation, makeup and physical effects and high-quality computer-generated effects. The program has professional and semi-professional video and audio gear along with high performance computers. 11. Physical Education and Fitness Centre

Grade 9 students take physical education all year long in combination with Career 09 in semester 1 and Health 09 in semester 2. Students are required to purchase a gym shirt and a gym lock at the beginning of the school year. It is the expectation that students are changed out and prepared to try their best at whatever activity they will be doing each day. Grade 10 students take Wellness 10 and students in grades 11 and 12 have the opportunity to take Physical Education 20 or 30 which focuses on recreational activities for a healthy, balanced lifestyle.



Students are given an orientation of the Fitness Centre and its equipment in one of their first physical education classes. A portion of their physical education classes will be opportunities to work out in the weight room and monitor their progress. Students can purchase a membership for \$30 for the year and workout in the space every lunch hour!
